We know that developing literacy is far more than just reading and writing. Literacy skills are also required for maths, technology, science, problem solving and for developing a 'Theory of Mind'.

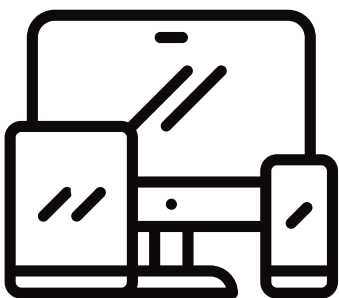
What is a Theory of Mind?

Having a theory of mind is an important social and cognitive skill and it helps us solve conflicts, to make and to keep friends.

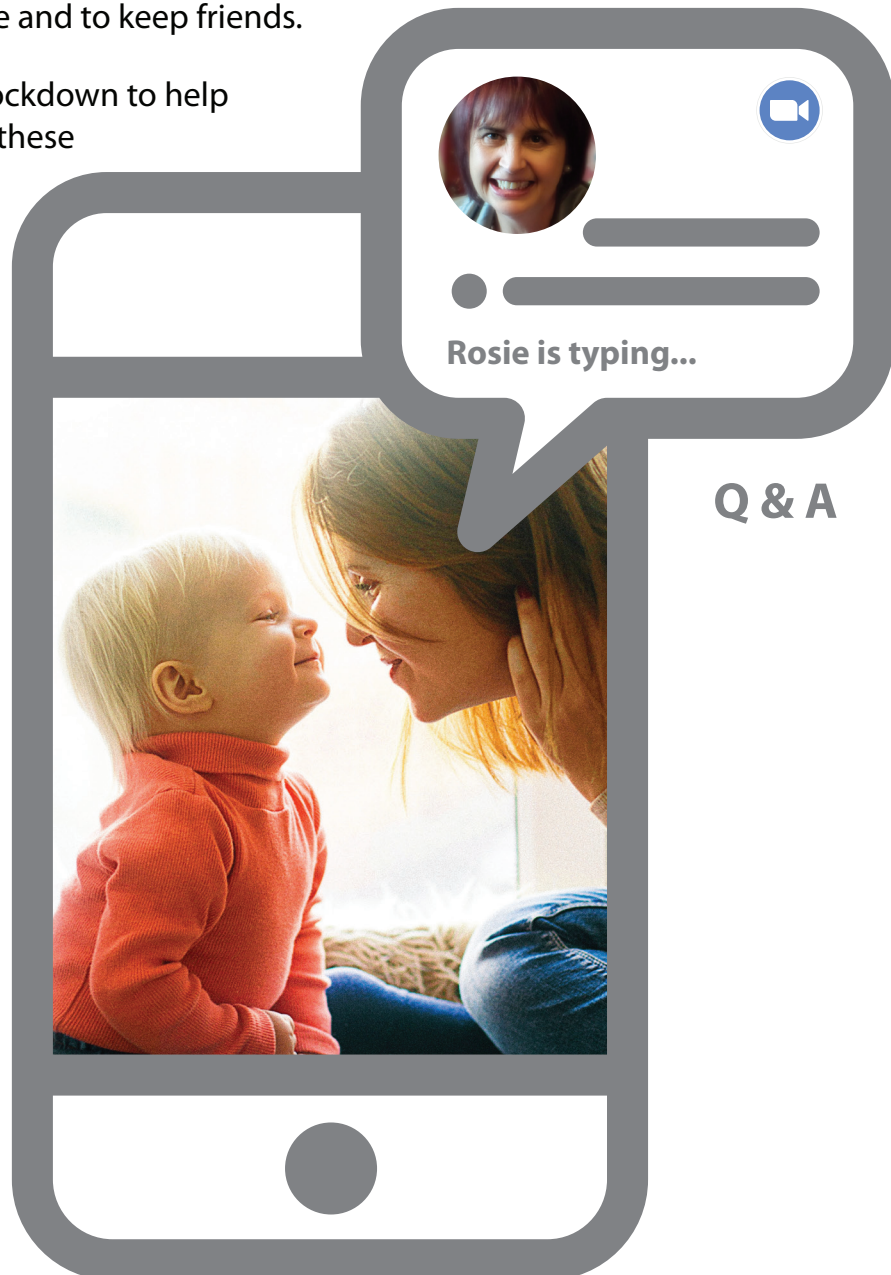
What can parents do during this time of lockdown to help their baby, toddler or older child develop these all-important skills?
